

Notice regarding the cessation of cohabitation

This notice must be given within two months after the cessation of cohabitation.

The spouse of a tenant or a person **who has been living with a tenant for at least 6 months**, being the common law spouse, a relative or an in-law, is entitled to maintain occupancy if he continues to occupy the dwelling after the cessation of cohabitation and gives notice to that effect to the landlord within two months after the cessation of cohabitation. He becomes the tenant from that moment.
